

Design a Bookmark Contest

The Iberia Parish Library, the Friends of the Library, Sir Speedy and *The Daily Iberian* are sponsoring the 22nd Annual Bookmark Contest for children to celebrate the 2020 Summer Reading Challenge. Children in preschool through grade six may enter their best efforts. Prizes will be awarded as follows:

- Preschool
- Grades K and 1
- Grades 2 and 3
- Grades 4, 5 and 6

Judges will base their decisions on three criteria – **originality, design** and **work that reflects the Summer Reading theme of “Imagine Your Story”**. Winning entries will be announced in ***The Daily Iberian***.

First and second place winners in all categories will be reproduced in full color by Sir Speedy and distributed throughout the parish at all locations of the Iberia Parish Library. First, second and third place winners will receive an official 2020 Summer Reading bag with goodies, t shirt and certificate. Honorable Mentions will receive a certificate and gift bag. Children may drop off their entries any time prior to Saturday, April 25th, 2020 at any branch of the Iberia Parish Library.

Guidelines:

1. All work must be original.
2. Popular figures (e.g. Disney characters, Curious George and others) cannot be considered due to copyright restrictions.
3. Entrants must qualify by grade category.
4. Any entry with marks outside the bookmark lines will be disqualified if those marks are essential to the artwork as a whole. This is because these ‘marks’ will disappear during the printing process.
5. Return unfolded entry form to any location of the Iberia Parish Library.
6. The decision of the judges is final.
