

Iberia Parish Library Local Author's Fair

The Iberia Parish Library would like to host a Local Author's Fair Saturday, November 15th from 10 AM - 2 PM outside at the courtyard by the Main Library, open to all ages. *In the event of inclement weather, the event will take place inside the Main Library.

In order to do so, we must have at least 10 local authors be willing to have a table at the fair. There is a cap on how many authors can participate, due to space limitations, so RSVP is first-come-first-served. If you or someone you know would be interested in participating, please review the guidelines below. The deadline for form submissions is Friday, October 24th:

1. The definition of "local" refers to an author living in the state of Louisiana.
2. The author must be 18 years of age or older.
3. You must bring your own table and chairs, no larger than 6ft long x 2.5ft wide. You must bring your own tent if the event takes place outside.
4. You must RSVP by Friday, October 24th by filling out the form which can be accessed through the library's website iberialibrary.org. (Please note the library must approve your application.)
5. You may sell your books and book-related merchandise, but you must handle all transactions. No library staff member will be able to handle your sales or make change. You cannot sell anything that is not related to your books, for example, you cannot sell food.
6. You must have authored a completed, published book, whether it is children's, young adult, adult, nonfiction or graphic novel. The book may be self-published, but must be currently available for purchase somewhere, whether in stores or online.
7. The library has the right to accept or refuse an author's participation.
8. If your application has been accepted, you will be contacted by the Iberia Parish Library's Public Relations Department, and you must sign and return the agreement of the above terms which will be sent upon approval.
