Local Author Fair

The Iberia Parish Library will host a Local Author Fair on Saturday, November 14th, from 10 AM - 2 PM at the St. Peter Branch (1111 W. St. Peter Street, New Iberia, LA 70560). It is open to all ages.

*In the event of inclement weather, the Local Author Fair will take place in the meeting room.

There is limited space, so those interested in participating should review the guidelines below and submit their application by October 16th.

1. *Local* refers to an author living in the state of Louisiana.
2. Authors must be at least 18 years of age.
3. You must bring your own table (6 ft x 2.5 ft) and chair. You may bring a tent. You must monitor your table and possessions. Library staff will not be responsible for your belongings or merchandise.
4. Please complete your application, which is available on the library's website, iberialibrary.org, by October 16th. The Community Relations Department must approve your application.
5. You may sell your books and book-related merchandise, but you are responsible for all transactions. Library staff will not complete your sales or make change. You cannot sell any items that are unrelated to your books; for example, you cannot sell food.
6. Your book can be self-published and in any genre or age group, but it must be currently available for purchase in stores or online.
7. Iberia Parish Library reserves the right to accept or refuse an author's application and participation.
8. If your application is accepted, the Iberia Parish Library's Community Relations Department will contact you. If selected, you must sign and return the *Contract for Participation* and agree to the above terms. The contract will be sent upon application approval.

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
