The Iberia Parish Library met in Regular Session at 10:30 a.m. on Wednesday, August 18, 2021 at the Main Library, New Iberia, Louisiana.

The President called the meeting to order at 10:40 a.m.

Gwen LeBlanc, President asked the library director to call roll. Board members present were Gwen LeBlanc, President; JoAnn Parker, Vice-President; Nathalie Leroux, and Katherine Courts. Councilman Marty Trahan and Assistant District Attorney Andy Shealy were also present.

Nathalie Leroux moved to accept the minutes of June 9, 2021. JoAnn Parker seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

The library director informed the board of a \$47,064.84 grant that the library received. She asked the board to consider approving using most of the grant to purchase Promethean boards for the different library locations. The breakdown of the grant would be:

21,554.42 to be used to purchase equipment to update the public computers.

JoAnn Parker moved to disburse the grant as recommended by the library director. Nathalie Leroux seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

After discussion JoAnn Parker moved to accept the 2022 library budget as presented. Nathalie Leroux seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

Mr. Andy Shealy suggested a possible next step for the library board in regards to the Delcambre branch library. JoAnn Parker suggested that the library board follow Mr. Shealy's advice and request that he continue his efforts on the library board's behalf. She also asked that the library director meet with the library director of the Vermilion Parish Library and come up with an outline to revise the intergovernmental agreement between the two libraries. Nathalie Leroux seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

There being no other business, JoAnn Parker moved to adjourn the meeting at 11:20 a.m. Nathalie Leroux seconded the motion. The next meeting was tentatively set for October 13<sup>th</sup> at 10:30am at the Main Library.
