The Little Free Library is where anyone can take a book to keep and to bring a book for someone else to have. **Do not return any library books you have checked-out here. Please, return your checked-out books inside the library.** These Little Free Libraries are books not catalogged in the library's system. You may bring books from your house to the Little Free Library for someone else to keep.

The Little Free Pantry is for anyone to take and leave non-perishable food and paper or hygiene products. This is for the community, built by the community. We ask anyone who is bringing something for the Little Free Pantry to bring **non-perishable foods only, such as, canned goods or dried beans.**

The Little Free Libraries and Little Free Pantries can be found at each branch of the Iberia Parish Library System. Anyone is welcome to take from and to replenish the Little Free Libraries and Pantries.

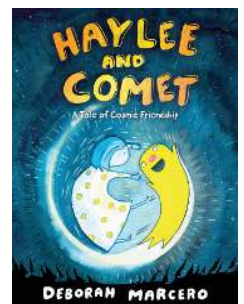
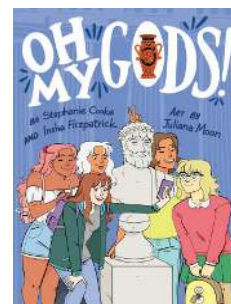
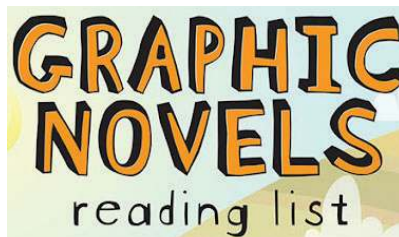
How do I know if a book is AR?

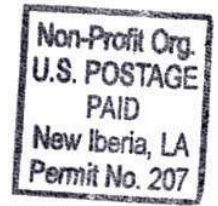
