

The first day to redeem for Summer Reading prizes upon completion is June 12.

1. Register at any Iberia Parish Library location or via Beanstack.
2. Read 50 books.
3. Come into any Iberia Parish Library location when finished to pick up your prize!

#### Children|Ages 6-12    Teens|Ages 13-17    Adults|Ages 18+

1. Register at any Iberia Parish Library location or via Beanstack.
2. Read to reach a goal of 2,000 minutes. (That's only 30 minutes a day five days a week!)
3. Come into any Iberia Parish Library location when finished to pick up your prize!




### New Library Cards

#### Library Cards

**THEY'RE HERE!** New library cards are available to ALL patrons for FREE for a limited time. These cards are designed by local artist, Kate Ferry. Each age group has a unique design, and a keychain card is included!

In compliance with Louisiana Revised Statute 25:225, these cards restrict library materials checked out to minors. Children ages 6-12 can check out materials from the Children's Department. Teens ages 13-17 can check out materials from the Children's Department and the Teen section of the library. Parents/Guardians have the choice to "Opt Out" of restrictions for their teens. Adults ages 18 and above have free access to all collections offered by the library.

The new cards are available at all Iberia Parish Library locations. Parents/Guardians **MUST** be with the child and/or teen to sign off on their new library cards.

All branches of your Iberia Parish Library have children's and teen books to fit the needs of each student.


### How do I know if a book is AR?
