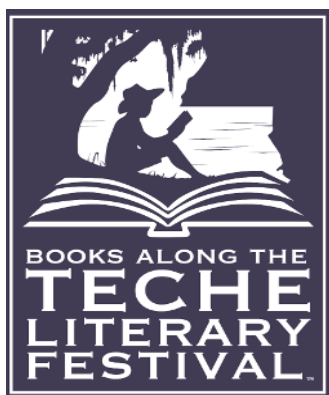

New Library Cards Coming This Year

Library Cards

THEY'RE HERE! New library cards are available to ALL patrons for FREE for a limited time. These cards are designed by local artist, Kate Ferry. Each age group has a unique design, and a keychain card is included!

In compliance with Louisiana Revised Statute 25:225, these cards restrict library materials checked out to minors. Children ages 6-12 can check out materials from the Children's Department. Teens ages 13-17 can check out materials from the Children's Department and the Teen section of the library. Parents/Guardians have the option to "Opt Out" of restrictions for their teens. Adults ages 18 and above have free access to all collections offered by the library.

The new cards will be available at all Iberia Parish Library locations. Parents/Guardians **MUST** be with the child and/or teen to sign off on their new library cards.



Louisiana Women in Flight

Gail Garcia will give a presentation about the Louisiana women who flew airplanes during World War II.

The presentation will give a small glimpse into the Louisiana women who broke through the traditional roles of their time to become aviators and supporters of the war efforts before and during the entering of the U.S. in World War II. These brave women became members of the Civil Air Patrol and Women Air Force Pilots (WASP) where they worked on and flew everything from small planes to bombers. These women faced many barriers including sabotage of their planes, discrimination, and the lack of being recognized for their service. **No registration required to attend.**

Alison Pelegrin was born and raised in New Orleans, Louisiana. She received an MFA from the University of Arkansas.

Pelegrin is the author of *Waterlines* (Louisiana State University Press, 2016); *Hurricane Party* (University of Akron Press, 2012); *Big Muddy River of Stars* (University of Akron Press, 2007), which received the 2006 Akron Poetry Prize; and *The Zydeco Tablets* (Word Press, 2002).

Pelegrin is the recipient of a grant from the Louisiana Division of the Arts and a fellowship from the National Endowment for the Arts. She teaches at Southeastern Louisiana University and lives in Covington, Louisiana. In 2023, she was appointed the poet laureate of Louisiana through 2025.

Effective March 13th, 2024 the Iberia Parish Library system will no longer offer access to Libby.

We are migrating our eBook and Audiobook service from Libby to cloudLibrary.



cloudLibrary™

cloudLibrary is an easy to use app with more titles and reduced wait times. Patrons will have access to 250,000+ copies of titles! We are also adding newsStand, which can be accessed through the cloudLibrary app. NewsStand will give patrons access to over 7,500 digital magazines and newspapers.

Libby users will be able to place holds through February 29 and borrow titles through March 5. Libby content will transfer to cloudLibrary on March 13.

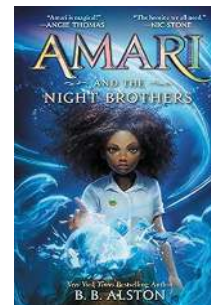
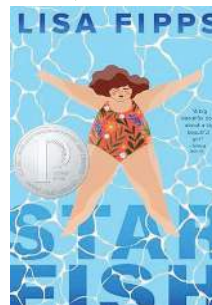
What is LYRC?

Accelerated Reader is a software program for K-12 schools for monitoring reading practice. The Iberia Parish Library may help you navigate your search for these books on your level. All branches of your Iberia Parish Library have children's and teen books to fit the needs of each student.

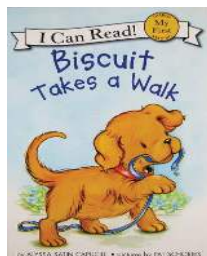
How do I know if a book is AR?
