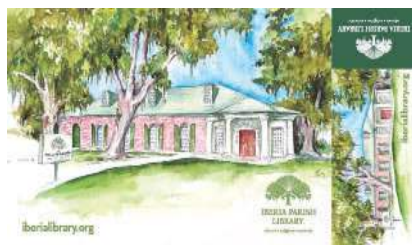
New Library Cards

Library Cards

THEY'RE HERE! New library cards are available to ALL patrons for FREE for a limited time. These cards are designed by local artist, Kate Ferry. Each age group has a unique design, and a keychain card is included!

In compliance with Louisiana Revised Statute 25:225, these cards restrict library materials checked out to minors. Children ages 6-12 can check out materials from the Children's Department. Teens ages 13-17 can check out materials from the Children's Department and the Teen section of the library. Parents/Guardians have the choice to "Opt Out" of restrictions for their teens. Adults ages 18 and above have free access to all collections offered by the library.

The new cards are available at all Iberia Parish Library locations. Parents/guardians MUST be with the child and/or teen to sign off on their new library cards.

Attention high school seniors and parents! The 2025-2026 FAFSA will be released on Sunday, Dec. 1, 2024! Representatives from the Louisiana Office of Student Financial Assistance (LOSFA) will be coming to the Main Library to take you through each step when filling out the FAFSA form. Before filling out the FAFSA Form, the student AND parent need a FSA ID.



FSA ID Completion: LOSFA representatives will assist both students and parents in creating their FSA ID at this workshop. The FSA ID is a combination of a username and password required to submit the FAFSA. Students and parents must have verified FSA IDs (this process will take 1-3 days) prior to starting the FAFSA. Students and parents will need access to their cell phones to create their FSA IDs.

FAFSA Completion Workshop: Students and parents will receive support completing their Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). LOSFA Representatives will provide step-by-step assistance during this workshop. Both students and parents need to bring their verified FSA IDs and tax return information from two years prior. For example, if a student is entering college as a freshman in the fall semester of 2025, students and parents need to bring tax information from 2023. Students and parents will also need access to their cell phones to log in to thestudentaid.gov website.

***Registration is required as spots are limited. Students and parents are required to attend BOTH the FSA ID Completion Workshop and the FAFSA Completion Workshop.**

A Look Into Accelerated Reading Levels

What is Accelerated Reader?

Accelerated Reader is a software program for K-12 schools for monitoring reading practice. The Iberia Parish Library may help you navigate your search for books on your level.

All branches of your Iberia Parish Library have children's and teen books to fit the needs of each student.

How do I know if a book is AR?

Each book has a stamp on the inside back cover or the first few pages. This stamp indicates the reading level, AR points, and a Quiz Number. If you are unsure of a book's AR information, a staff member will be happy to assist you!

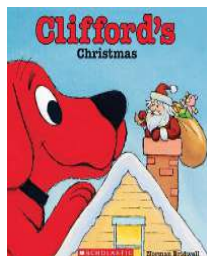
