As of now, we are excited to once again offer in-person programming and public meeting room access to the community. These operations and services are subject to change due to any unforeseen circumstances, including, but not limited to recommendations and policy changes enacted due to COVID-19. Mask Policies

Masks or face coverings are required for ages 5 and older while inside library facilities, in accordance with the current statewide mask mandate. In the event that the mask mandate is lifted, it is at the library's discretion that the masks will continue to be enforced until further notice.

What is Accelerated Reader?

Accelerated Reader is a software program for K-12 schools for monitoring reading practice. The Iberia Parish Library may help you navigate your search for these books on your level.

All branches of your Iberia Parish Library have children's and teen books to fit the needs of each student.

How do I know if a book is AR?

Each book will have a stamp on the inside back cover or the first few pages. This stamp will indicate the reading level, AR points, and a Quiz number. If you are unsure of a book's AR information, a staff member would be happy to assist you!
