Workshop Registration 2023

This year the Iberia Parish Library's Summer Workshop Program celebrates its 38th year. The registration schedule is as follows:

Week 1 Workshops (June 5–June 9) registration opens Tues, May 30 at 9:30 AM

Week 2 Workshops (June 12-June 16) registration opens Mon, June 5 at 9:30 AM

Week 3 Workshops (June 20-June 23) registration opens Mon, June 12 at 9:30 AM

Week 4 Workshops (June 26-June 30) registration opens Tues, June 20 at 9:30 AM

Week 5 Workshops (July 3-July 7) registration opens Mon, June 26 at 9:30 AM

Week 6 Workshops (July 10 – July 14) registration opens Mon, July 3 at 9:30 AM

Registration will take place via Evanced, our online calendar. You can find Evanced by going to iberialibrary.org and clicking the "Calendar of Events" tab at the top of the page OR by going directly to **iberia.evanced.info/signup**. Summer workshops will always be the color YELLOW and be labeled as "Summer Workshop" on Evanced.

You may <u>NOT</u> register via the phone. **Registration will be online or in-person ONLY**. Please do not register for more than one session of a single workshop. Duplicate registrations will be cancelled. Space is limited for each workshop so make sure to register as soon as you can to better your chances of getting in. **Workshops are first come, first served. Please note, workshops are subject to date changes or cancellation, dependent on weather or other unforeseen circumstances.**

I'm so excited to be coordinating this summer's workshop program at the Iberia Parish Library. This year's workshops will deliver many opportunities for our children to indulge in experiences that are not readily available in our schools and homes.

Registration Rules & Recommendations

1. We recommend that you write down special dates like vacations or summer camps that could interfere with your workshop choices before registering. Please take note of the workshop location before registering, as not all workshops are located at the same branch. We ask that you please only register for workshops that you know that your child will be able to attend.

2. Registration for each week of workshops begins the Monday prior to that week; holidays and library closures may affect this. These dates are listed out in previous sections of this booklet. Registration will close the day before each workshop at 3 PM. All of this information is also available to you via Evanced, 24/7.

3. If a workshop is filled by the time you go to register, you may still sign up for the waiting list. **This does not guarantee you a spot**. In the event of cancellation before the day of the workshop, registrants are automatically moved from the top of the waiting list to the registered list. If your child is moved to the registration list, you will be notified. Be sure to list a correct phone number where you can be reached easily during the summer.

4. The waiting list becomes void the day of the workshop. Those who would like to try and attend and are **NOT** registered may come and join the stand-by list 30 minutes before the workshop start time. Any last-minute cancellations and no-shows will be filled from this list: first come, first served. **Stand-bys must be present when they are called.**

5. Some workshops have multiple sessions. Please register for only **ONE** session of a single workshop. Duplicate registrations will be cancelled. If a workshop is filled, you may join the waiting list for however many sessions you would like to have a better chance of getting in. However, in the event that the child is moved to the registered list due to a cancellation, the child may only attend one session of that workshop.

Registration Rules & Recommendations

6. You may sign-up for as many workshops as you'd like, but **the child must meet all requirements and you must completely fill out the registration information** (age, dress code, allergy information, contact information, etc) for each workshop or your child will not be allowed to attend.

7. Registration is based on the age the child will be on the day of that workshop.

Ex: Timmy is 9 years old, but his birthday is the day before the Star Wars Day workshop (open to ages 10-17). Timmy may register for Star Wars Day because he will be within the age range requirement the day of the workshop.

8. Please call the library to cancel if you can not make a workshop so that those on the waiting list have a chance to attend. We also ask that you call the workshop location beforehand if you are planning on coming but think that you might be late. If we do not receive a call and you are not there for the workshop start time, according to the library's clock, you forfeit your spot.

9. Please note that Evanced, the events calendar where registration will take place, may be temporarily down due to routine maintenance that is out of the library's control at some point over the course of the summer. In the event that the website is down, please wait patiently and try again.

10. Please feel free to ask the staff for more information about workshops and for help with navigating Evanced within the registration process. Should you have any questions or concerns, please call the Main Library at 364-7150 after Tuesday, May 30.
