# Workshop Registration 2024

This year is the Iberia Parish Library's first Adult Summer Workshop Program since 2011!

The registration schedule is as follows:

Week 1 Workshops (June 3—June 7) registration opens Tues, May 28 at 9:30 AM

Week 2 Workshops (June 10—June 14) registration opens Mon, June 3 at 9:30 AM

Week 3 Workshops (June 17—June 21) registration opens Mon, June 10 at 9:30 AM

Week 4 Workshops (July 1—July 5) registration opens Mon, June 24 at 9:30 AM

Week 5 Workshops (July 8 —July 12) registration opens Mon, July 1 at 9:30 AM

Week 6 Workshops (July 15 —July 19) registration opens Mon, July 8 at 9:30 AM

Registration will take place via Evanced, our online calendar. Find Evanced by going to [iberialibrary.org](http://iberialibrary.org) and clicking the "Calendar of Events" tab at the top of the page OR by going directly to [iberia.evanced.info/signup](http://iberia.evanced.info/signup). Summer workshops will always be the color DARK BLUE and be labeled as "Summer Workshop" on Evanced.

You may NOT register via the phone. **Registration will be online or in-person ONLY.** Please do not register for more than one session of a single workshop. Duplicate registrations will be cancelled. Space is limited for each workshop, so to better your chances of getting in, log on when registration open. **Workshops are first come, first served. Please note, workshops are subject to date changes or cancellation, dependent on weather or other unforeseen circumstances.**

# Registration Rules & Recommendations

1. We recommend that you write down special dates like vacations or your children's summer camps that could interfere with your workshop choices before registering. Please take note of the workshop location before registering, as not all workshops are located at the same branch. **We ask that you please only register for workshops that you know that you will be able to attend.**
2. Registration for each week of workshops begins the Monday prior to that week. Holidays and library closures may affect this. These dates are listed on the previous page of this booklet. Registration will close the day before each workshop at 3 PM. All of this information is also available to you via Evanced, 24/7.
3. If a workshop is filled by the time you go to register, you may still sign up for the waiting list. **This does not guarantee you a spot.** In the event of cancellation before the day of the workshop, registrants are automatically moved from the top of the waiting list to the registered list. If you are moved to the registration list, you will be notified. Be sure to list a correct phone number where you can be reached easily.
4. The waiting list becomes void the day of the workshop. Those who would like to try and attend and are **NOT** registered may come and join the stand-by list 30 minutes before the workshop start time. Any last-minute cancellations and no-shows will be filled from this list: first come, first served. **Stand-bys must be present when their name is called.**
5. Some workshops have multiple sessions. Please register for only **ONE** session of a single workshop. Duplicate registrations will be cancelled. However, if a workshop is filled, you may join the waiting list for multiple sessions to better your chances of getting in. In the event that you are moved to the registered list due to a cancellation, you may only attend one session of that workshop.

# Registration Rules & Recommendations

6. You may sign-up for as many workshops as you'd like, but **you must meet all requirements. Fill out the registration information completely** (age, allergy information, contact information, etc) for each workshop, or you will not be allowed to attend.

7. All adult workshops are for those age 18 and older. Registration is based on the age you will be on the day of that workshop.

*Ex: Erica is 17 years old, but her birthday is the day before the Watermelon Wreath workshop (open to ages 18+). Erica may register for the Watermelon Wreath because she will be within the age range requirement the day of the workshop.*

8. Please call the library to cancel if you can not attend a workshop so that those on the waiting list have a chance to attend. We also ask that you call the workshop location beforehand if you plan to attend but might be late. **If we do not receive a phone call and you are not present for the workshop start time, according to the library's clock, you forfeit your spot.**

9. Please note that Evanced, the events calendar where registration takes place, may be temporarily unavailable due to routine maintenance that is out of the library's control at some point over the course of the summer. In the event that the website is down, please wait patiently and try again.

10. Please feel free to ask the staff for more information about workshops and for help with navigating Evanced during the registration process. Should you have any questions or concerns, please call the Main Library at 364-7150 after Monday, May 28.

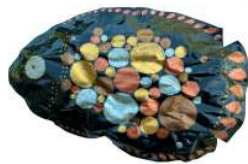
