This year the Iberia Parish Library's Summer Workshop Program celebrates its 40th year!

Registration will take place via our online calendar. Find this calendar by going to iberialibrary.org and clicking the "Calendar of Events" tab at the top of the page. Summer workshops will always be the color YELLOW and be labeled as "Summer Workshop."

Registration will be online, in-person, or over the phone. Please do not register for more than one session of a single workshop. Duplicate registrations will be cancelled. Space is limited for each workshop, so to better your chances of getting in, log on when registration opens.

Workshops are first come, first served. Please note, workshops are subject to date changes or cancellation, dependent on weather or other unforeseen circumstances.

This year's workshops will deliver many opportunities for our community to indulge in

experiences that are not readily available in our schools and homes.

Registration Rules & Recommendations

- 1. Before registering, We recommend that you write down special dates like vacations or summer camps that could interfere with your workshop choices. Please take note of the workshop location before registering, as not all workshops are located at the same branch. We ask that you please only register for workshops that you know that your child will be able to attend.
- 2. Registration for each week of workshops begins the Monday prior to that week. Holidays and library closures may affect this. These dates are listed on the previous page of this booklet. Registration will close the day before each workshop at 3 PM. All of this information is also available to you via our online calendar, 24/7.
- 3. If a workshop is filled when you go to register, you may still sign up for the waiting list. **This does not guarantee you a spot**. In the event of a cancellation before the day of the workshop, registrants are automatically moved from the top of the waiting list to the registered list. If your child is moved to the registration list, you will be notified. Be sure to list a correct phone number where you can be reached easily.
- 4. The waiting list becomes void the day of the workshop. Those who would like to try and attend and are **NOT** registered may come and join the stand-by list 30 minutes before the workshop start time. Any last-minute cancellations and no-shows will be filled from this list: first come, first served. **Stand-bys must be present when their name is called.**
- 5. Some workshops have multiple sessions. Please register for only **ONE** session of a single workshop. Duplicate registrations will be cancelled. However, if a workshop is filled, you may join the waiting list for multiple sessions to better your chances of getting in. In the event that the child is moved to the registered list due to a cancellation, the child may only attend one session of that workshop.

Registration Rules & Recommendations

- 6. You may sign-up for as many workshops as you'd like, but **the child must meet all requirements. Fill out the registration information completely** (age, allergy information, contact information, etc) for each workshop, or your child will not be allowed to attend.
- 7. Registration is based on the age the child will be on the day of that workshop.

Ex: Timmy is 7 years old, but his birthday is the day before the Wilderness Survival workshop (open to ages 8—10). Timmy may register for Wilderness Survival because he will be within the age range requirement the day of the workshop.

- 8. Please call the library to cancel if you can not attend a workshop so that those on the waiting list have a chance to attend. We also ask that you call the workshop location beforehand if you plan to attend but might be late. If we do not receive a phone call and you are not present for the workshop start time, according to the library's clock, you forfeit your spot.
- 9. Please note that the events calendar where registration takes place may be temporarily unavailable due to routine maintenance that is out of the library's control at some point over the course of the summer. In the event that the website is down, please wait patiently and try again.
- 10. Please feel free to ask the staff for more information about workshops. Should you have any questions or concerns, please call the Public Relations Department at 364-7024 ext. 6 after Monday, May 26.
