

Update as of Wednesday, August 4, 2021

Please review the following information regarding our services and operations:

- In accordance with the Governor's mask mandate, effective Wednesday, August 4, all branch locations of Iberia Parish Library require mandatory masks or face coverings.
- All library branches will be opened at 75% capacity. You may be asked to wait before entering the building in order for our staff to regulate the 75% capacity limit.
- There will be a limited amount of public computers available at each branch to better adhere to the social distancing recommendations. *Please note that as our staff will be adhering to the social distancing recommendations, it is recommended that if you believe you will require help while using the public computers that you bring someone to assist you.*
- Please note that public restrooms are available, however, water fountains remain unavailable.
- Programs and events will remain online/virtual until further notice.
- Meeting rooms will be unavailable for booking until further notice.

*Please note that, depending upon the COVID levels in the fall and the policies and restrictions at the time, the Iberia Parish Library is hopeful that it may begin in the fall a soft transition into in-person programming and meeting room availability. This is subject to change and will be revisited and evaluated at the end of August.

We continue to urge the public to utilize the library's FREE online resources available through iberialibrary.org.
