Overview & Purpose

To create a piece of artwork that depicts what the library means to the individual student. This can be based on personal experiences with the library and its programs and resources or a general idea of what the libraries mean to the individual student.

This art competition is open to children and teenagers from ages 5 to 17. **There will be two categories with a winner from both categories:** Ages 5 - 11 and ages 12 - 17.

The winning artworks will be featured on the library's social media accounts and in the upcoming *Online Resources Newsletter* which is distributed at all locations of Iberia Parish Library and mailed to members of the Friends of the Library.

Materials Needed

- 1. One plain white piece of paper, not exceeding 8 ½ inches by 11 inches. (Please do not use lined paper, construction paper, etc... Plain white computer paper would work best.)
- 2. Artistic medium of their choice: pen, colored pencil, crayon, markers, etc...Please do note that if the drawing is done in pencil we strongly encourage that the drawing is lined in pen so that it can be seen if it is run through the copy machine in the case of it winning.
- 3. Entry form attached with the artwork when submitted, completely filled-out.

Further Information:

- 1. Artwork must be submitted to the Main Library NOW until Monday, February 1st. February 1st is the FINAL deadline for submissions.
- 2. Individuals may submit artwork OR teachers may submit artwork if multiple individuals in their class are participating in the project.
 - **Must have parental or guardian's permission if the student is under the age of 18, with the understanding that the parent, guardian, or student must pick up the artwork by the pick-up deadline if they wish to have the artwork back.
- 3. All artwork that is submitted must be accompanied by the entry form, completely filled-out or the artwork will not be accepted.
- 4. All artwork that is submitted will be displayed during the month of February at the Main Library. The winning pieces of artwork will also be featured on the library's social media and in the upcoming *Online Resources Newsletter*, distributed at all branch locations.
- 5. If you would like to pick-up your artwork, you may do so from March 1 March 5. All artwork that is not picked up by March 5 will be discarded.
